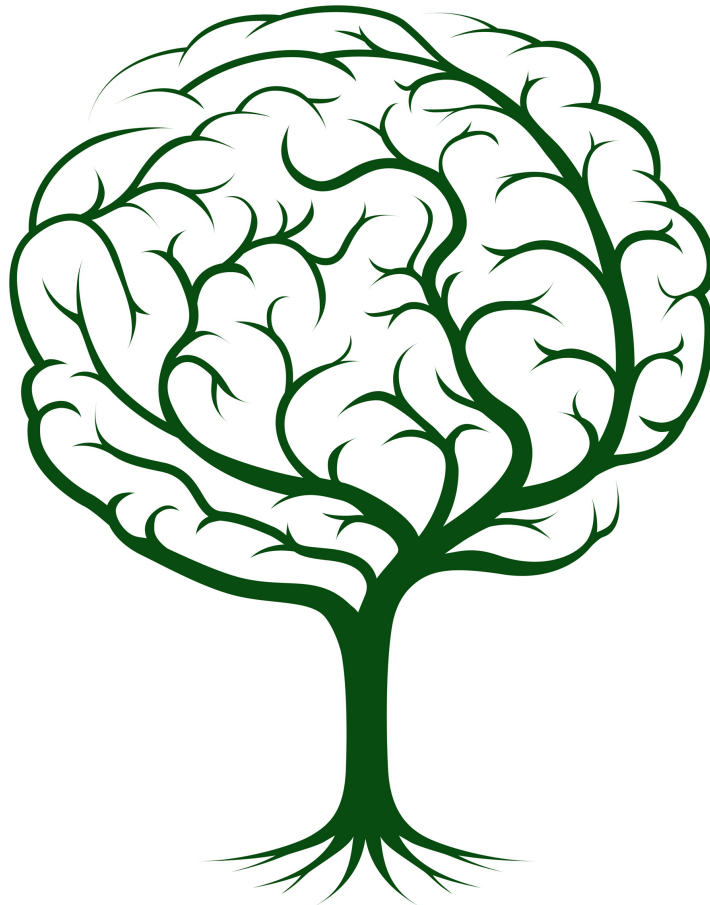

Symptom Tree

The Brain Gauge comes with the Symptom Tree questionnaire that has been developed to reveal the root cause of the symptoms you are experiencing and a primary part of the Concussion Active Prevention.
